This funding will be used to:

- Improve the school's NAPLAN performance to be at or above 'like schools' in reading and writing;
- Deepen teacher knowledge and expertise in the systematic and rigorous delivery of the Australian Curriculum;
- Ensure that all staff have the resources required to enact the whole-school improvement agenda;
- Enhance the provision of specialist support staff.

Our initiatives include

- Facilitate teacher professional development focusing on the systematic and rigorous delivery of the Australian Curriculum:
 - Planning opportunities to give feedback in units with clear links to student goals.
 - Using formative assessment and feedback to enhance student learning.
 - Embedding formative assessment and moderation practices into teaching practice.
- Continued focus on reading and numeracy.
- Provide additional Speech Language support.
- Develop an ongoing cycle of data collection to monitor individual student progress.
- Employ support staff to support the school reading program.
- Additional literacy and numeracy resources.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Teacher professional development: Delivery of the Australian Curriculum – \$135 000
- Teacher professional development: Establishment of formative moderation practices – \$40 920
- Speech language provision - \$22 000
- Curriculum Coordinator - \$84 000
- Resourcing additional classroom support for prioritised areas: Teacher Aides \$100 000
